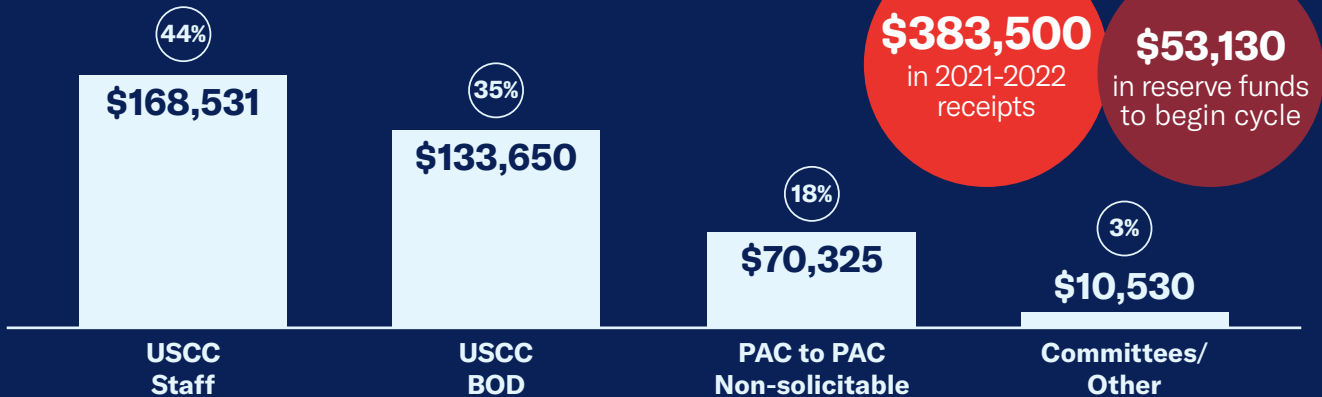

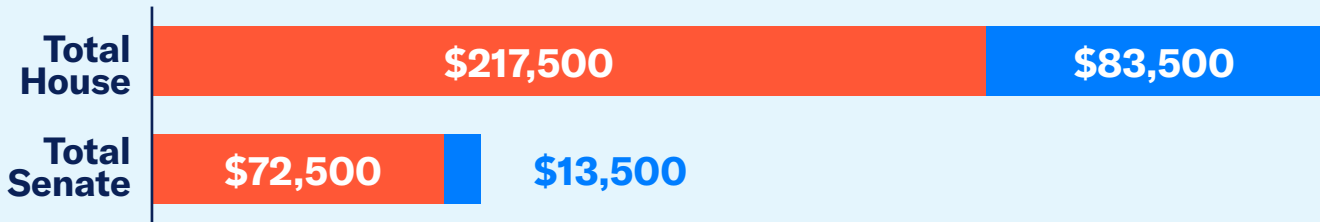

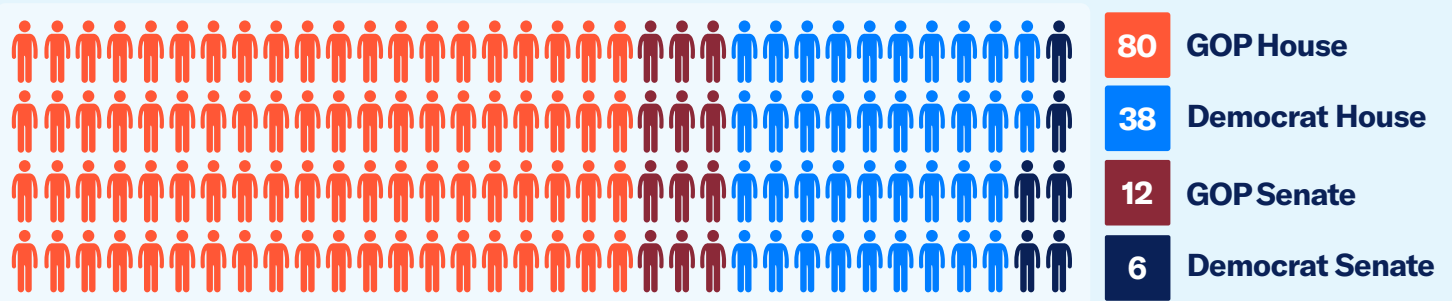

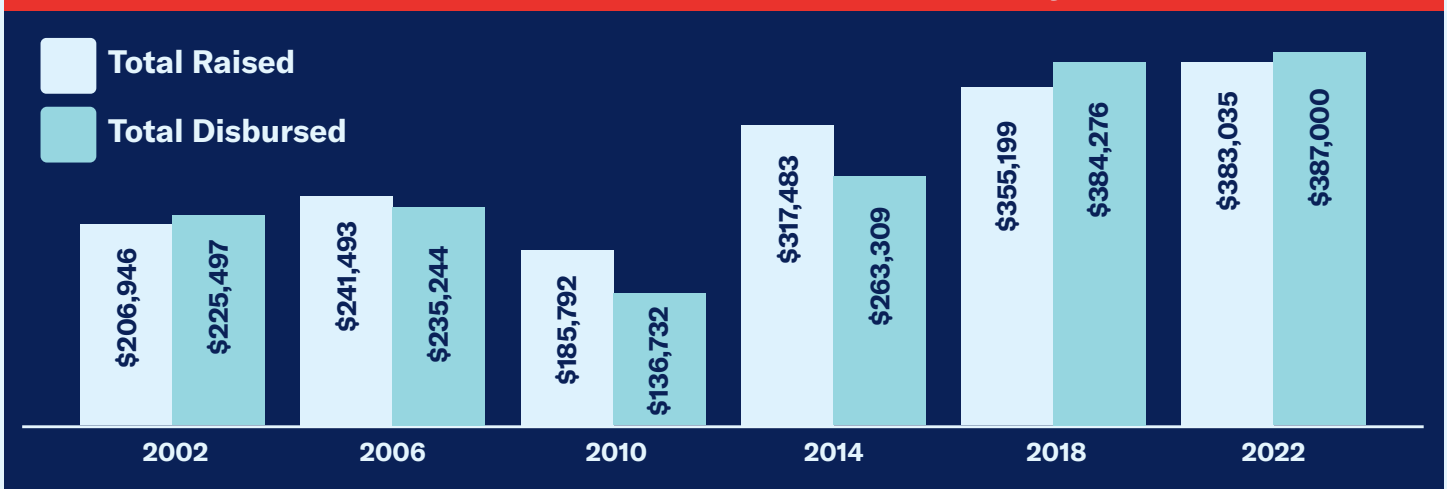
Disbursements by the Numbers

Historical PAC Data in Midterm Election Cycles

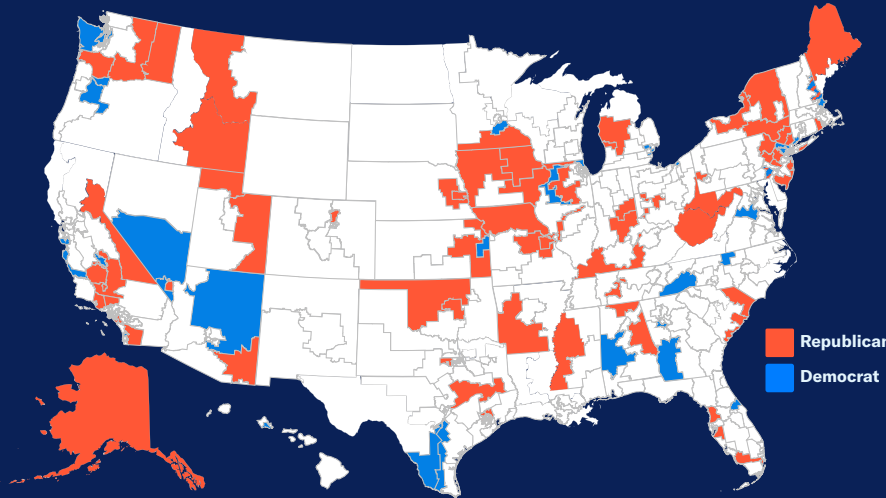
